APPLICATION PROCESS: All applications must be accompanied with three images of work to be exhibited and one photograph of your booth on a CD in JPEG format. Applications accompanied with unreadable CD's will be rejected. CD will not be returned.* The Show Committee will "jury" all entries and notify applicants of acceptance. Once an artist is accepted, a contract will be forwarded with additional details.
